We have developed our wine list to reflect modern and traditional wine philosophies. Building relationships with several boutique importers and a few main stream distributors has enabled us to represent many wine producing nations around the world. Our mission is to provide our guests with an eclectic and intriguing selection.

All of our wines are temperature controlled and served in Riedel stemware. When needed or requested, tableside decanters are used to exhibit the truest qualities of our wines.

We offer ½ glass pours, wine tasting flights, wine pairings, and half bottles. Half bottle flights provide further diversity in both wine and food sampling. Our wine by the glass program uses the vac-u-vin system with a strict bottle dating policy to ensure the guest always enjoys a fresh glass.

Our wine training, although relatively informal, is hands-on, with tastings for the staff along with open forum discussions that take place on a daily basis. We are fortunate to have a staff that is both knowledgeable and interested.

In addition to our everyday wine program, we frequently have wine tastings, and a monthly wine dinner. In every aspect of our wine program it is our goal to make wine attainable for all people and to find the right wine for each palate. Our sommelier, Ken Norcutt, carefully pairs each wine with a balanced plate designed to bring out the fullness of the glass.

Every wine tells a story and through travel and experience we have collected many stories. The wines on our list are wines that we love, from people that we care about, and of places we have been. In short each wine is a story we have chosen to share with you.
